Wednesday, April 25 at 2:30 p.m.

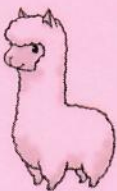
Make a cool block breaker game with the Scratch programming language! Bring a flash drive to take your game home with you. For teens in grades 6-12. Registration is required.
