

Pool Rules

1. Obey Lifeguards.
2. Do not talk to lifeguards while on duty.
3. Only swimming suits and towels are allowed in the pool area.
4. Spectators are not permitted in the pool or deck or with street clothes on.
5. Non-toilet trained babies must wear diapers and rubber pants.
6. Children under 6 years of age and non-swimmers should be accompanied by a responsible person 18 years of age or as determined by the pool manager.
7. Flips, back dives, twists are not allowed (2 steps to enter water from deck).
8. No diving
9. Do not walk in the gutters or hang on the ropes.
10. The pool will reopen 30 minutes after the last sign of an electrical storm.
11. No one is allowed in the pool or deck area with infectious/communicable diseases.
12. Persons having open blisters, cuts, sores are advised not to use the pool.
13. Running, pushing, wrestling, dunking, splashing or causing undue disturbance in or about the pool will not be tolerated.
14. The following articles are NOT allowed in the pool area:
 - Bottles / glass
 - Clothing / bags
 - Radios, etc.
 - Diving masks, fins, snorkels
 - Food / drink
 - Flotation devices (except U.S. Coast Guard Approved Lifejackets)
 - Sunscreens, lotions, oils
 - Footwear
 - Cigarettes
 - Balls / toys
 - Alcoholic beverages
 - Strollers
 - Lawn Chairs
 - Band-aids
 - Weapons
 - Beepers / cell phones
15. Patrons will be dismissed from the pool and/or park for the following reasons:
 - Improper conduct
 - Causing injury to others
 - Intoxication
 - Improper swim wear
 - Failing to obey rules
 - Pollution of pool or grounds (spitting, discharge of bodily wastes)
16. Abusive or profane language and gestures will not be tolerated.
17. The pool may be closed or its use limited at any time because of weather, operational difficulties, overcrowding, or at the discretion of the manager.

18. Leave valuables locked in the car. Management will not be responsible for loss or damage to any personal property of any kind.
19. The management reserves the right to refuse admittance, to eject from the pool and/or park premises, any persons failing to comply with any of the above health and safety regulations. Also, **NO TRESPASSING** after hours of operation. Anyone entering the premises after operational hours will be subject to arrest
